Dear Current or Prospective Student,

The Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) requires that Institutions make available to their students information regarding certain outcomes of their nursing programs.

To follow is the 2018 data. This information is required to be disclosed for the 2019 calendar year. Please understand that each year the annual reports are due near the end of the calendar year. As a result, the rates disclosed for the current year are from the previous year's calculated data. Disclosures are updated within a reasonable timeframe after calendar year-end.

This information is compiled based on the requirements and accreditation standards established by ACEN. These standards can be located at: <http://www.acenursing.org/accreditation-manual/>. The student specific data is maintained, tracked and updated in our student data base system.

The following are the rates regarding our student graduates' success on the licensure examination to become a Registered Nurse, students' completion of the nursing program, and the percentage of students who have obtained a job within a specified timeframe after graduation.

The methodology and time frame applicable to these rates is as follows:

Licensure Exam Rate Methodology

The licensure exam rates are based on first year candidates who took the exam from January 1, 2018 thru December 31, 2018. These rates are based on the 2018 calendar year results as reported by the Colorado Board of Nursing. These results may differ slightly from the pass rates reported to ACEN on the annual report due to the timing differences of the annual report submission vs. the release of the Colorado Board of Nursing calendar year-end exam results.

Completion Rate Methodology

The annual reporting period is July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. The graduation rate cohort is for student's that have graduated between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018. Graduation statistics are calculated per program and are compiled based on the requirements of ACEN.

Placement Rate Methodology

The annual reporting period is July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. The placement rate cohort is for student's that have graduated between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018. Placement statistics are calculated per program and are compiled based on the requirements of ACEN.

Placement rates are calculated by dividing employed graduates by total graduates. To be considered a placement the student must have graduated and must meet the following requirements:

- Graduates must be licensed as a Registered Nurse (RN) with a state board in the U.S.
- Graduates must be employed a minimum of 5 days
- Excludes those who have returned to formal education

Placements are determined by a graduate working in their field. Placement information is verified with the employer. For examples of types of employment obtained by our graduates, please review your catalog and/or consult with your Career Service's office.
