Licensure Exam Pass Rate

Licensure Exam rates are based on first time candidates who took the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN) from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. These rates are based on results as reported by the Colorado Board of Nursing.

- Number of students who started the first nursing course in the program from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.
- Number of students who graduated within 150% of expected program length, starting with the first nursing course.
